A. POLICY

Consistent with the Workforce Investment Act, the Washington State Strategic and Operations Plans for workforce development, and the Snohomish County Workforce Development Council Strategic and Operations Plans, the following Income Guidelines are to be used in determining if a given youth is low-income based on family income relative to family size for Program Years 2010 starting on the Effective Date, above. Consistent with State policy, these guidelines are those established for the Seattle-Tacoma-Bremerton Metropolitan Statistical Area.

Family Size	Amounts
1	\$10,890
2	\$16,947
3	\$23,267
4	\$28,720
5	\$33,894
6	\$39,636

For each additional family member, add \$5,742.

The family of one figure shown is based on the Poverty Income Level effective January 20, 2011. All other figures in this column are based on 70% of the Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL) effective March 21, 2011.
