UPDATED AMOUNT AVAILABLE

This procurement action will award a contract or contracts for Program Year 2009-2010. The total amount available is **\$500,000** in Adult funds and **\$700,000** in Dislocated Worker funds for Program Operation and **\$285,000** in Adult funds and **\$405,000** in Dislocated Worker funds for Site Operation. This is an estimate only and is based on Program Year 2008-2009 funds and anticipated funding from the American Recovery and reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA): contract awards will be based upon actual available funding.

Note that a minimum of \$80,000 in Adult funds and \$120,000 in Dislocated Worker funds need to be allocated for participant costs. Participant costs **are to be placed in the Site Operator budget** and are managed by the Site Operator. As of March 5, 2009 there were no participant dollars obligated for the 2009 Program Year. This is certainly subject to change before the start of the contract period and will be updated as information changes.

The chart below details the current split of the totals available between regular WIA formula allocations and ARRA allocations. These splits will change as allocations are released. Bidders **do not** need to submit separate budgets for the purpose of this procurement activity; however, bidders should be aware that final contracts will be a mix of WIA formula and ARRA allocations. This will result in separate contracts based on type of funding (Adult or Dislocated Worker) and funding stream (WIA formula or ARRA) based on the splits from actual allocations. These estimates should be helpful to bidders during budget creation.

including an AmeriCorps member (regardless of funding stream) will need to show a clear link between the member and enrolled participants. Accepted bids will need to provide a brief summary of this link for inclusion in the contract and will be required to do additional reporting showing this link.
